

(Southern/Miami Division)




Administrative Order 2002-02 modified the Magistrate Judge Pairing Assignment Plan for the Southern/Miami Division. The modifications effectuated by this Order are for a period of three years commencing April 1, 2002, and will expire on March 31, 2005, subject to the following amendments. It is hereby

ORDERED that, commencing November 1, 2002, Magistrate Judge Ted E. Bandstra will be paired with Senior United States District Judge William M. Hoeveler. The pairing of Magistrate Judge Robert L. Dubé with Senior United States District Judge William M. Hoeveler is hereby vacated.

It is further noted that consistent with Administrative Order 2002-44, Magistrate Judge Robert L. Dubé is, and will be until further notice, the assigned Magistrate Judge on all land condemnation cases, and that the assignment of all land condemnation cases to Magistrate Judge Andrea M. Simonton are vacated consistent with Administrative Order 2002-45.

This Order vacates only those portions of Administrative Order 2002-02 that are inconsistent with the changes herein stated. Administrative Order 2002-02 otherwise remains in full effect.
