

CIVIL CASES




Due to the death of Senior Judge Norman C. Roettger, and pursuant to Sections 2.07.00 and 3.03.00 of the Court Policy Manual, it is herein

**ORDERED** that all pending civil cases originating in the Key West division that were assigned to Senior Judge Roettger as of the date of his passing be transferred to the Honorable James Lawrence King forthwith. It is further

**ORDERED** that Magistrate Judge Barry S. Seltzer shall effect the transfer of those cases that are currently referred to him by certifying that all pending fully briefed motions have been resolved and ordering that the Clerk transfer the cases to Magistrate Judge John J. O'Sullivan, who is paired with Judge King. Those cases which are not referred may be administratively transferred to the new Magistrate Judge by the Clerk upon the direction of Magistrate Judge Seltzer. The Clerk shall promptly execute the transfers to the new Magistrate Judge, and upon doing so shall immediately change the cases' Magistrate Judge designation to Magistrate Judge John J. O'Sullivan.

Clerk's Office is directed to ensure that counsel of record in all transferred cases is noticed of the transfer via the Court's Faxback program
