### **Reappointment of Judge Raymond B. Ray Bankruptcy Court, Southern District of Florida United States Courts**

The current 14-year term of Judge Raymond B. Ray, for the United States Bankruptcy Court, Southern District of Florida, at Fort Lauderdale, Florida, is due to expire on November 8, 2007. The United States Court of Appeals for the Eleventh Circuit is considering Judge Ray's request for reappointment to a new 14-year term.

Upon reappointment, Judge Ray, would continue to perform the statutory responsibilities of a bankruptcy judge as specified in Titles 11 and 28 of the United States Code, the Bankruptcy Amendments and Federal Judgeship Act of 1984, Pub. L. No. 98-353, Sections 101-122, 98 Stat. 333-346.

Members of the bar and the public are invited to submit written comment for consideration by the Court of Appeals concerning the reappointment of Bankruptcy Judge Ray to a new term of office.
