

ORDER OF SUSPENSION

The above named attorney pled guilty to one felony count of conspiracy to commit bank fraud in a criminal case in this Court, United States vs. Dosen, 09-cr-20730. The Supreme Court of Florida then suspended him from practicing law in Florida, following an April 5, 2010 order.

Rule 4(a) of the Southern District of Florida Attorney Discipline Rules provides in pertinent part: "Upon the filing with this court of a certified copy of a judgement of conviction demonstrating that any attorney admitted to practice . . . has been convicted . . . of any serious crime . . . the Court shall enter an order immediately suspending that attorney. . . . That suspension so ordered shall remain in effect until final disposition of the disciplinary proceedings to be commenced upon such conviction." Given this background, pursuant to Rule 4(a) of the Rules Governing Attorney Discipline of the Southern District of Florida, and the Court's inherent power to regulate membership in its bar for the protection of the public interest,

IT IS ORDERED that said attorney be suspended from practice in this Court, effective immediately. The Clerk of Court shall strike this attorney from the roll of attorneys eligible to practice in the United States District Court for the Southern District of Florida, and shall also immediately revoke his CM/ECF password.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED by this Court that said attorney advise the Clerk of the Court of all pending cases before this Court in which he is counsel or co-counsel of record.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED by this Court that attorney Ryan Thomas Dosen is directed to

keep this Court advised of further action taken by the Florida Bar, by filing a Notice with this Court within five (5) days of the issuance of any further Orders in the state disciplinary proceedings.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED by this Court that the Clerk of Court shall serve a copy of this Order of Suspension upon the attorney at his court record address and Florida Bar address.
