

Accordingly, this case is hereby set for trial during the two-week period beginning on **March 12, 2012**. Calendar call will be held at 9:00 a.m. on the preceding Tuesday, **March 6, 2012**, at the Wilkie D. Ferguson, Jr. United States Courthouse, 400 N. Miami Avenue, Courtroom 12-3, Miami, Florida. A pretrial conference will be held immediately following calendar call only if requested by the parties in advance.

1. The parties shall comply with the following schedule:

Jan. 20, 2012	Deadline for the filing of pretrial motions, including motions <i>in limine</i> and <i>Daubert</i> motions
Feb. 27, 2012	Deadline to file joint pretrial stipulation pursuant to Local Rule 16.1(e) and pretrial disclosures pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 26(a)(3). Deadline to file proposed jury instructions (if the matter is set for a jury trial) or proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law (if the matter is set for a bench trial) pursuant to Local Rule 16.1(k).



This list must indicate the pre-marked identification label (e.g., P-1, or D-A) and must also include a brief description of the exhibit.

5. Deposition Designations. Any party intending to use deposition testimony as substantive evidence must designate by line and page reference those portions in writing. The designations must be served on opposing counsel and filed with the Court fourteen days before the deadline to file the joint pretrial stipulation. The adverse party must serve and file any objections and any cross-designations within seven days. The initial party shall then have seven days to serve and file objections to the cross-designations.

6. Voir Dire Questions. The Court will require each prospective juror to complete a brief written questionnaire prior to the commencement of questioning in the courtroom. Any party may file, no more than five proposed, case-specific questions to be included in the questionnaire. The proposed questions must be filed with the Court at the time of the joint pretrial stipulation, and shall also be submitted via e-mail at [scola@flsd.uscourts.gov](mailto:scola@flsd.uscourts.gov) in MS Word format (.doc).

7. Settlement Notification. If this matter is settled, counsel are directed to inform the Court promptly via telephone (305-523-5140) and/or e-mail ([scola@flsd.uscourts.gov](mailto:scola@flsd.uscourts.gov)).
