Fraud Involving Magistrate's Court Summons

Recently, attempted "Magistrate's Court Summons" scams have begun to be reported in the Southern District of Florida. Individuals have reported being contacted over the telephone and via email and requested to pay overdue balances on Payday and other loans and tax obligations. Our Court never makes requests for payment of overdue balances for loans or tax obligations over the telephone or via email. Unless a person is actively involved in a case in federal court and has consented to receive court notifications electronically, they generally will not be served with court documents electronically. Persons receiving a "Magistrate's Court Summons" should not make the payment, but instead contact the court from which the alleged summons purports to have originated [[district court directory](#)]. In addition, immediately file a complaint with the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) Internet Crime Complaint Center at [www.ic3.gov](http://www.ic3.gov).

It is also a crime to falsely represent oneself as a federal court employee. If anyone receives a telephone call or email regarding a federal court case or matter which they are unaware of, or if they suspect a fraudulent call, contact the clerk's office at [their nearest district court](#).
