

AFTER APRIL 1, 1985




The honorable Joe Eaton, United States District Judge, has announced his intention to assume the status of a Senior United States District Judge, on April 2, 1985. The attached memorandum from Judge Eaton to the Clerk of Court dated March 7, 1985, sets forth the type and number of case assignments Judge Eaton desires after assuming senior status. It is therefore

ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that commencing April 1, 1985, the Clerk of Court will assign to Judge Eaton at 50% case assignment of that number of civil cases assigned to an active United States District Judge, and a 50% assignment of criminal cases in categories I, II, and III, of that assignment normally given to an active District Judge. It is further

ORDERED that the clerk not assign category IV or V criminal cases, or emergency assignments, after April 1, 1985.
