ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 85-2 1

LOCAL RULES, AS AMENDED :

Upon consideration, it is

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED as follows:

1. Local Magistrate Rule 4(a) shall consist of two paragraphs, with the existing text to be become 4(a)(1).

2. New Magistrate Rule 4(a)(2) shall provide as follows:

At the conclusion of a bond hearing pursuant to 18 U.S.C. §3142 in which a Magistrate has set a bond which will result in release of a defendant if the conditions of the bond are met, an announcement in open Court by the prosecutor that the government intends to appeal the bond to a District Judge shall result in an immediate stay of the bond set by the Magistrate. Such stay shall continue until 5:00 p.m. that day, or in the event bond is set in open Court after 5:00 p.m., until 9:30 a.m. the morning of the following business day, unless the prosecutor shall file a written notice of appeal with the Clerk, upon which the stay shall become permanent unless and until it is lifted by a District Judge. The notice of appeal may be summary in form and need not be typed, but it shall be followed on or before the close of the

business day next following the day the bond was set by the filing of a detailed factual statement, in proper form, setting forth the grounds of the appeal.
