ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 85-47

IN RE: POLICY STATEMENT REGARDING
DISCLOSURE OF PRESENTENCE
INVESTIGATIONS

THAT A COPY of the presentence reports prepared by the federal probation department shall be provided to the counsel of record for disclosure to his client and to prosecutors ten days prior to sentencing.

NO COPIES OR ANY OTHER DISSEMINATION of the confidential report or information contained therein shall be made. Unauthorized copying or disclosure will be an act in contempt of court and be punished accordingly.

OBJECTIONS TO THE PRESENTENCE shall be submitted, in writing, to the assigned probation officer and the Court five days prior to sentencing.

THE PRESENTENCE REPORT is to be returned to the probation department on date of sentencing. Failure to so comply will be an act in contempt of court.

THE U. S. PROBATION DEPARTMENT is to establish procedures necessary to implement this order.
