THIS MATTER AROSE upon the Report and Recommendation
of the Sentencing Guideline Administration Committee of the
United States District Court for the Southern District of
Florida, pursuant to the Supreme Court's Decision, USA V.
MISTRETTA.

1. IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED the Probation Office prepare
a "guideline worksheet" for all presentence reports prepared
prior to January 18, 1989, on those defendants pending
sentencing and subject to the Sentencing Reform Act.

2. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that to provide
adequate time for the preparation and disclosure of the
guidelines, sentencings on applicable defendants shall be
post-poned for at least ten (10) days. The Probation Department
shall immediately notify the Court, prosecutor and defense
attorney as to the identity of those defendants.

3. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that Administrative
Order 87-50 is reinstated for the sentencing of defendants
convicted subsequent to January 18, 1989. Administrative
Order 88-23 is rescinded.
