ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE


A certified copy of a judgment entered by the Supreme Court of the State of Florida dated March 9, 1989, has been filed with this court. This judgement states, in part:

"Accordingly, we approve the referee's report and hereby disbar Richard G. Newhouse from the practice of law without leave to reapply for a period of 20 years, consecutive to the tenure prohibition imposed by this court in **The Florida Bar v. Newhouse**, 520 So.2d 25 (Fla. 1988)."

Therefore, pursuant to the Rules of Disciplinary Enforcement, United States District Court, Southern District of Florida, Rule 2(B), you are directed to file with this court, within 30 days after service of this Order to Show Cause, why the imposition of the identical discipline by this court would be unwarranted and the reasons therefore.

Thereafter, pursuant to Rule 2(D), this court shall impose the identical discipline unless any element in Subparagraph (D) exists, at which time the court shall enter such other order as is appropriate.
