This matter having come before the court upon the recommendation of Robert M. March, Clerk for the Southern District of Florida, and the court being satisfied that the procedure described below is in compliance with Title 28, United States Code, App. II, Sections 303 and 305(b)(2), it is therefore

ORDERED that all requests for examination of financial disclosure reports will be made on the appropriate request form, AO-10A. Multiple requests will be made on a single form. Such written requests will be addressed to the Financial Administrator. A copy of the request form (AO-10A) will be provided to the Chief Judge and all pertinent judicial officers. In any instance where the Clerk deems that the request may be used for unlawful purposes, the Clerk or his designee will notify the affected judicial officer(s) by telephone as the records are being examined. Any copies requested will be provided in accordance with the fee schedule established by the Judicial Conference of the United States.
