The Judicial Improvements and Access to Justice Act of 1988, realigned certain counties between the Southern and Middle Districts of Florida. Then, on February 19, 1989, pursuant to this act Collier, Glades and Hendry Counties were transferred from the Southern District to the Middle District of Florida.

There are two criminal cases in a fugitive status that have remained in the Naples Division. Therefore, effective this date, the two remaining Naples cases listed below, which include four fugitive defendants, are hereby transferred to the Middle District of Florida:


