
On July 13, 1990, a Clerk Committee of the Southern District of Florida was created by Administrative Order No. 90-86 (appended hereto). With the resignation of Judge Scott on October 31, 1990, it became necessary to appoint a new chairperson and add a new member. It is therefore,

ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that The Honorable William J. Zloch be, and he is hereby, appointed as chairperson of the Clerk Committee of the court. It is further

ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that The Honorable Lenore C. Nesbitt be, and she is hereby, appointed as a member of this committee.

The committee shall consist of Judge Zloch, Judge Nesbitt, and Judge Moreno, and is charged with the same mandate of responsibility as previously outlined in Administrative Order No. 90-86, together with the various policies adopted by the court pertaining to the office of the Clerk.
