
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 91-45

**IN RE: APPOINTMENT OF REPORTER FOR
CIVIL JUSTICE ADVISORY GROUP FOR
THE SOUTHERN DISTRICT OF FLORIDA**

Title I of the Judicial Improvements Act of 1990, Public Law No. 101-650, signed by the President on December 1, 1990 consists of legislation titled the "Civil Justice Reform Act of 1990". This Act, more commonly known as the "Biden Bill", seeks reductions in the costs and delay of civil litigation in the United States District Courts through significant contributions by the courts, litigants, litigants' attorneys, Congress, and the Executive Branch (28 U.S.C. § 102.3). In furtherance of this legislation, this court has been designated an early implementation district with the hope to have a plan in place by December 31, 1991.

In accordance with these actions the court hereby appoints Tracy Nichols, Esquire as the official reporter for the Civil Justice Advisory Group for the Southern District of Florida as delineated under 28 U.S.C. § 478 (e).
