
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 91-54

**IN RE: FORWARDING CLOSED CASE
FILES TO THE FEDERAL RECORDS
CENTER / AMENDMENT TO LOCAL
RULE 8D**

Due to an expanding case load and problems involving space and maintenance of case files, the Court finds it is no longer efficient to maintain case files for a full five years. Therefore, it appearing that there is good cause to amend Local Rule 8D, it is hereby ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that Local Rule 8D is amended to read as follows:

CLOSED FILES. Upon order of the Chief Judge, the files in all actions or proceedings not pending nor on appeal, may be forwarded to the Federal Records Center serving this District. Thereafter, persons desiring use of any such files may, upon good cause shown on appropriate form furnished by the Clerk, request that such files be returned for examination in the Clerk's Office.
