COURTROOMS AND CHAMBERS FOR  
SENIOR AND ACTIVE JUDGES**

Because the district has been fortunate in having more courtrooms and chambers than judges in the past, this may be a non-problem. However, if there is a delay in bringing courtrooms and chambers on stream, the district may have a definite problem as of 1992 or early 1993 if all three of our judges eligible to retire in senior status in 1992 elect to take senior. In several districts this has become a problem usually because of the otherwise happy circumstance of having several senior judges.

In the hope that a policy can be adopted in as academic a fashion as possible in order to obviate the possibility of hurt feelings if and when the district does face the problem, the following committee is appointed to look into this situation and to report back to the judges with their suggestions by the November 20, 1991 judges' meeting.
