Administrative Order 88-36, dated September 23, 1988, designated the smoking areas in the West Palm Beach Paul G. Rogers Federal Building and United States Courthouse as the public areas directly adjacent to the elevators on each floor occupied by the Court. In light of recent federal and state health warnings about the dangers of secondhand smoke,

IT IS ORDERED, in addition to previously designated "no smoking" locations, the areas directly adjacent to the elevators on each floor occupied by the Court in the West Palm Beach Federal Building and United States Courthouse be designated as **No Smoking** areas. Consistent with FPMR 101-20.105(e), the GSA Buildings Manager will place appropriate "No Smoking" signs at conspicuous locations throughout those floors.

Pursuant to Administrative Order 88-36, court unit executives with offices in the West Palm Beach Federal Building and United States Courthouse have submitted to the Court, via the Office of the District Executive, a plan designating smoking areas for employees in their respective offices. Court unit executives are hereby delegated the authority to determine whether smoking areas should be designated within their respective offices. If they elect to do so, such areas must not negatively impact worker productivity, or impinge on the health of those who do not smoke.
