On March 11, 1993, at a regularly scheduled Judges' Meeting, a Motion was made and passed that the case assignment system for the Northern Division be adjusted to improve the likelihood of a West Palm Beach case being assigned to a West Palm Beach Judge.

Therefore, it is hereby Ordered and Adjudged that the Clerk of Court create a new West Palm Beach Wheel for both Civil A and B cases and Criminal Category I and II cases. The distribution of the ballots will be based upon a 3:1 proportion. This equates to the following judgeship representation:<sup>1</sup>
