

Judge Nesbitt has also agreed to accept assignment of Judge Marcus' cases representing appeals from the Bankruptcy Court.

She is to receive no further civil transfers of the Marcus cases.

After Judge Marcus advises the Clerk which civil cases he will retain, the balance shall be randomly assigned in the following manner:


Judge Kehoe is to receive the number of cases he needs to meet his law clerk quota for 1998. The balance of cases are being reassigned to all Active Judges except Judges Nesbitt and Highsmith, with due regard to the North-South Divisions. Judge Middlebrooks is to be included in the reassignment of Palm Beach cases.

**CRIMINAL CASES:**

After assignment of one criminal case each to Judges Atkins and Hoeveler, the balance of Judge Marcus' criminal cases shall be reassigned to all Active District Judges randomly, except for the Category III and Category IV cases which will be placed in their respective wheels for immediate reassignment.

Judge Marcus has agreed to close approximately 20 criminal cases before commencing his Eleventh Circuit assignments on January 5, 1998.
