

CASE LOAD TO MAGISTRATE JUDGE TED E. BANDSTRA**




In order to equalize the workload of the Magistrate Judges after implementation of the pairing plan as provided for in Administrative Order No. 99-27, it is hereby

ORDERED that effective Monday August 9, 1999 Magistrate Judge Ted Bandstra shall be paired with U. S. District Judge Patricia Seitz for Judge Seitz's criminal case load only. Magistrate Judge Garber shall continue to be the Magistrate Judge assigned to handle Judge Seitz's civil referrals; it is further

ORDERED that commencing Monday, August 9, 1999 the Clerk of the Court shall commence assigning Magistrate Judge Bandstra to all new criminal cases assigned to Judge Seitz and shall transfer Judge Seitz's criminal cases from Magistrate Judge Garber to Magistrate Judge Bandstra pursuant to orders of transfer which shall be prepared by Magistrate Judge Garber.
