

01-CV-3593, Beckless v. United States


It is further **ORDERED** that all matters presently pending in the following closed cases will be likewise transferred to the Honorable Paul C. Huck forthwith:

purposes on all cases herein transferred, except for that class of pro se prisoner cases that are normally assigned to Magistrate Judge Charlene Sorrentino pursuant to Administrative Orders Numbers 89-31 and 96-55, which shall remain with Judge Sorrentino.
