

01-CV-2781, Henao-Quevedo v. United States


It is further **ORDERED** that all matters presently pending in the following closed cases will be likewise transferred to the Honorable Donald M. Middlebrooks forthwith:

Magistrate Judge Andrea Simonton, who was formerly paired with Judge Nesbitt, shall remain the assigned Magistrate for all purposes on all cases herein transferred, except for that class of *pro se* prisoner cases that are normally assigned to Magistrate Judge Charlene Sorrentino pursuant to Administrative Orders Numbers

89-31 and 96-55, which shall remain with Judge Sorrentino.
