

Pursuant to the authority conferred by Title 28, United States Code, Section 631, et seq., and the further authority granted in action taken by the Judicial Conference of the United States, it is hereby

**ORDERED** that PATRICK A. WHITE be, and he is hereby, appointed as full-time United States Magistrate Judge at Miami, Florida, at an annual salary as fixed by the Judicial Conference of the United States. It being further

**ORDERED** that United States Magistrate Judge White shall commence performance of his duties on the 2nd day of April, 2003, upon taking the oath or affirmation prescribed by Title 28, United States Code, Sections 453 and 631(g), and shall hold and discharge the duties of his office for a term of eight years from the date of appointment, subject to the provisions of Title 28, United States Code, Section 631(e), unless sooner relieved. It being further

**ORDERED** that the Clerk of Court will cause certified copies of this order to be entered upon the record of this Court, and shall

forward a certified copy of this order and the appropriate documents of appointment to the Director of the Administrative Office of the United States Courts.
