

ORDER OF DISBARMENT




It has been shown to the Court that the Supreme Court of Florida has disbarred the above-named attorney from practicing law in Florida, effective immediately, following a September 12, 2002, order. Pursuant to the Rules Governing Attorney Discipline, United States District Court, Southern District of Florida, it is ORDERED that said attorney be disbarred from practice in this court, effective immediately, following the September 12, 2002, Supreme Court of Florida order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED by this court that the Clerk of Court mail Richard Ignacio Martinez a copy of this Order of Disbarment.
