Magistrate Judge Lurana S. Snow shall effect the transfer of those cases that are currently referred to her by certifying that all pending fully briefed motions have been resolved and ordering that the Clerk transfer the cases to either Chief Magistrate Judge Ann E. Vitunac or Magistrate Judge Linnea R. Johnson, who are paired with Judge Middlebrooks. Those cases which are not referred may be administratively transferred to the new Magistrate Judge by the Clerk upon the direction of Magistrate Judge Snow. The Clerk shall promptly execute the transfers to the new Magistrate Judge, and upon doing so shall immediately change the case's magistrate judge designation to Chief Magistrate Judge Vitunac or Magistrate Judge Johnson.

The Clerk's Office is directed to ensure that counsel of record in all transferred cases is noticed of the transfer via the Court's Faxback program.
