

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2005-52

APPOINTMENT OF REGINALD D. MICHAEL
AS CHIEF UNITED STATES PROBATION OFFICER

IT APPEARING that a vacancy exists for a Chief Probation Officer in the United States District Court for the Southern District of Florida upon the retirement of Chief Probation Officer Frank Schwartz, and that Reginald D. Michael is well qualified to perform the duties of such office as determined by a majority of the Court's judges on September 19, 2005, it is

ORDERED that Reginald D. Michael be, and he is hereby, appointed Chief United States Probation Officer for the Southern District of Florida effective January 3, 2006 and as such shall have such powers as are fixed by the Statutes of the United States relating to such matters. It is further

ORDERED that the Clerk will cause certified copies of this order to be entered upon the record of this Court, and shall forward a certified copy of this order and the appropriate documents of appointment to the Administrative Office of the United States Courts.

This order supercedes Administrative Order 94-65.
