
IN RE: ASSIGNMENT OF BANKRUPTCY APPEALS

Administrative Order 2006-14 modified Assignment of Bankruptcy Appeals until June 30, 2007. Consistent with that order (amending prior order 2005-30), and pursuant to a decision made by the full Court at a regularly scheduled Judges' Meeting, it is

ORDERED that all newly filed bankruptcy appeals and related matters will continue to be randomly assigned to a limited pool of District Judges. That pool shall consist of The Honorable Alan S. Gold, The Honorable Adalberto Jordan, and The Honorable Cecilia M. Altonaga. The Clerk's Office is directed to take the steps necessary to implement and maintain case assignment procedures consistent with the instant order, if and until modified by further Order of Court.

This Order supersedes Administrative Orders 2005-30 and 2006-14 and shall be effective nunc pro tunc to June 30, 2007.
