

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2008-27

IN RE: ASSIGNMENT OF
BANKRUPTCY APPEALS



Administrative Order 2005-30 entered on July 1, 2005, established a pilot project for the assignment of Bankruptcy Appeals for a period of one year. That Order directed the assignment of those Bankruptcy appeals on a random basis to a limited group of Judges comprised of Judges Alan S. Gold, Adalberto J. Jordan, and Cecilia M. Altonaga. The term of that pilot project was extended for limited periods via subsequent Administrative Orders 2006-14 and 2008-18. Pursuant to a decision made by the full Court, for purposes of efficiency and economy, it has been determined that the pilot project for assignment of Bankruptcy Appeals should be made permanent. Accordingly, it is

ORDERED that henceforth, all newly filed bankruptcy appeals and related matters will continue be randomly assigned to a limited pool of District Judges. That pool shall consist of Judges Alan S. Gold, Adalberto J. Jordan, and Cecilia M. Altonaga. The Clerk's Office is directed to take the steps necessary to implement case assignment procedures consistent with this Order. This directive for assignment of bankruptcy appeals to the limited pool of District Judges identified above shall continue indefinitely, without further Order or extension, unless and until modified by further Order of this Court.

This Order supersedes Administrative Orders 2005-30, 2006-14 and 2008-18.
