

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2009-13

**IN RE:
APPOINTMENT OF MAGISTRATE JUDGE
STEPHEN T. BROWN AS CHIEF UNITED
STATES MAGISTRATE JUDGE**



Pursuant to the Court's Internal Operating Procedures, Section 4.02.00, the District Judges may select one full-time Magistrate Judge to serve as the Chief Magistrate Judge performing administrative functions. Inasmuch as the Court established in March 1994 a schedule to rotate the position of Chief Magistrate Judge based on seniority. The three year term of Chief Magistrate Judge Ted E. Bandstra will expire April 9, 2009, and Magistrate Judge Stephen T. Brown is next due to assume the position of Chief Magistrate Judge pursuant to the schedule of seniority. Accordingly, it is

ORDERED that Magistrate Judge Stephen T. Brown is hereby appointed as Chief Magistrate Judge vice Magistrate Judge Ted E. Bandstra.

Magistrate Judge Brown's appointment as Chief Magistrate Judge shall be for a three-year term effective April 10, 2009.
