

IN RE: APPOINTMENT OF SPACE &
FACILITIES COMMITTEE



Consistent with the discussions of the last Judges' meeting and in view of the new policies set forth by the Judicial Conference, the Court creates its own Space and Facilities Committee for the Southern District of Florida. The Committee shall recommend to the Court how to efficiently use courtrooms and chambers in the district. In view of the new eligibility of District Judges to take senior status, the probability of Congress passing a new judgeship bill creating three new judgeships, and the Judicial Conference's policy to share courtrooms, the Committee shall recommend to the Court what actions should be taken to address the availability of courtroom and chambers' space, particularly in Fort Lauderdale and West Palm Beach, where space is at a premium.

IT IS ORDERED that the following District Judges are appointed as members of the Southern District of Florida's Space and Facilities Committee.

Chair: Judge William P. Dimitrouleas (Fort Lauderdale)

Members: Judge James Lawrence King (Senior, Miami)
Judge Kenneth L. Ryskamp (Senior, West Palm Beach)
Judge Adalberto Jordan (Miami)
Judge James I. Cohn (Fort Lauderdale)
Judge Marcia G. Cooke (Miami)

The Committee shall obtain information on space from the Clerk of Court and report to the Court before **April 30, 2010**. Any proposal shall be put to a vote at the Judges' meeting in Fort Lauderdale set for **May 13, 2010**.
