ORDER OF REINSTATEMENT

THIS CAUSE is before the Court on attorney Jesus Novo III's Petition For Reinstatement as a member of the Bar of this Court. That Petition was referred to the Court's Ad Hoc Committee for Attorney Admissions, Peer Review and Attorney Grievance. On January 13, 2010, the Committee issued a Report and Recommendation finding that Mr. Novo had made the necessary showing for readmission to the Court's bar, and recommending that he be reinstated with one condition pursuant to Rule IX.D of this Court's Rules Governing Attorney Discipline [current Rule 9(d)] that "for the first five matter (sic) before this court he must appear together with a co-counsel who is a member in good standing of the bar of this Court and not be designated lead counsel for these matters." Report at 3.

Pursuant to Rule IX.D [current Rule 9d)], having reviewed the Petition, attachments to the Petition, and being fully advised, the Court approves the Committee's Report and Recommendation and finds that Jesus Novo III ("Petitioner") qualifies for readmission to this Court's Bar. The Court further orders that Petitioner is reinstated as a member in good standing of the Bar of this Court, subject to the aforementioned condition that for the first five matters before this Court he must appear together with a co-counsel who is a member in good standing of the Bar of this Court and not

be designated lead counsel for these matters.
