

**ORDER ON MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION OF DENIAL OF MOTION FOR
RECONSIDERATION ENTERED ON DECEMBER 10, 2010**

On December 17, 2010, this Court received a third motion from the above-named attorney in response to this Court's October 14, 2010 Order of Suspension, which was based upon the Florida Supreme Court's three (3) year suspension of attorney Scott in The Florida Bar v. Scott, 39 So. 3d 309 (Fla. 2010). Scott has not raised any new issues in this third motion that would warrant reconsideration of this Court's December 17th Order or the granting of additional time for Scott to support his motion with portions of the record. Rule 5(e) of the Rules Governing Attorney Discipline clearly set out the applicable grounds in order to contest reciprocal discipline. None of Scott's motions have raised sufficient grounds under Rule 5(e) for reconsideration.

Future multiple successive motions will not be entertained by this Court and pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 11 and this Court's inherent power, the filing of such may result in sanctions.

Given this background, and the Court being fully advised of the matter, it is

ORDERED that Scott's Motion for Reconsideration of Denial of Motion for Reconsideration Entered on December 10, 2010 is DENIED.
