
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2013-56

IN RE: AMENDED DESIGNATION OF BANKRUPTCY
JUDGE PAUL G. HYMAN, JR. AS CHIEF BANKRUPTCY
JUDGE

Pursuant to Title 28 U.S.C. § 154(b), the District Judges unanimously confirm the prior designation of Bankruptcy Judge Paul G. Hyman, Jr. as Chief Bankruptcy Judge for the Southern District of Florida. The Court notes that, unlike the specific criteria required by Congress in 28 U.S.C. § 136 for Chief District Judges, the 1984 Bankruptcy Act contains no age or seniority requirement. The District Judges, by unanimous vote, have reiterated the “full faith and confidence” expressed by former Chief Judge Zloch in his order of August 21, 2006 appointing Judge Hyman. Because of the impending move of the Bankruptcy Judges from the Claude Pepper Federal Building to the Atkins Tower Courthouse in Miami and the numerous serious budget issues facing the Bankruptcy Court during the next couple of years, the Court desires for continuity. Therefore, it is

ORDERED, ADJUDGED, and DECREED that Bankruptcy Judge Paul G. Hyman, Jr. continues to be designated as Chief Bankruptcy Judge of the United States Bankruptcy Court, Southern District of Florida, until further order of the Court.
