Administrative Order 2012-98 on the Magistrate Judge Pairing Assignment Plan is amended as of April 1, 2014 due to the expiration of the three-year term for pairing Magistrate Judges with District Judges in the Miami division of the Court. It is

ORDERED that the following will be the pairings beginning on April 1, 2014:

All matters referred prior to March 1, 2014 shall be disposed by the Magistrate Judge currently paired with the District Judge irrespective of whether the motion is "ripe" or not. If the case is referred for all discovery matters or referred in full, the Magistrate Judge must complete the work necessary to rule on the pending matters before there is a referral to the newly-paired

Magistrate Judge. All consent matters shall be retained by the original paired Magistrate Judge.
