

**IN RE: ADJUSTMENT TO CRIMINAL CASE  
ASSIGNMENT SYSTEM**

After reviewing the respective indictments issued by Miami Grand Juries that get assigned to Fort Lauderdale District Judges, the Court has determined that it is appropriate to adjust the case assignment system. Therefore, it is

ORDERED that the Clerk of Court is directed to assign to District Judge Robert N. Scola, Jr. criminal cases as if he were a Miami Judge. The parties, witnesses, and lawyers will be saved the time, money and effort to travel to Fort Lauderdale, when the criminal case originated in Miami. Judge Scola will continue to be assigned civil cases as a Fort Lauderdale Judge.
