ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2016-60

**IN RE: AMENDMENT TO ADMINISTRATIVE ORDERS
2015-79 AND 2016-55, DUTY JUDGE ASSIGNMENT
SCHEDULE, WEST PALM BEACH AND FORT PIERCE**



Administrative Order 2015-79 established the Duty Judge schedule for West Palm Beach during calendar year 2016. Due to the recent retirement of District Judge Kenneth L. Ryskamp, the Court amends that order to remove Judge Ryskamp from the schedule for the remainder of the year. Accordingly, the following is the amended schedule for November and December 2016 as to the West Palm Beach Division.

Additionally, Administrative Order 2016-55 established the Duty Judge schedule for West Palm Beach and Fort Pierce for calendar year 2017. Pursuant to the Internal Operating Procedures of the United States District Court for the Southern District of Florida, IOP 8.00.00, the following is the amended schedule for January 2017 through December 2017, as to the Duty Judge for West Palm Beach and Fort Pierce:

FORT PIERCE ASSIGNMENTS



Judge Donald M. Middlebrooks will serve as the back-up Fort Pierce Duty Judge in the event Judge Robin L. Rosenberg is unavailable.

The Duty Judge should be present in the district and available for handling Duty Judge matters at all times during the month assigned. If it is necessary for the Duty Judge to be out of the district for a short period of time during the assignment month, it is the Duty Judge's responsibility to make arrangements with another Judge to handle all Duty Judge matters arising during the brief absence, and to notify the Chief Judge and Clerk of Court of his or her absence.

The Duty Judge's functions are consistent with the Court's Internal Operating Procedures, IOP 8.01.00.
