## FOURTH SCHEDULING ORDER

THIS CAUSE came before the Court for a Status Conference on November 15, 2021 [ECF No. 74]. Following an unopposed *ore tenus* motion for extension of time by counsel for Defendant Mednax, the Court hereby directs the parties to adhere to the following revised schedule:

Joint Motion to Dismiss: Defendants' joint motion to dismiss is due January 6, 2022 and shall not exceed 60 pages. The parties shall instead attend a status conference on **December 15, 2021 at 1:00 PM.** The conference will be held via video conference, with instructions to follow. The parties shall submit a joint proposed agenda listing items for discussion at the December status conference by **December 10, 2021**.
