FIRST SCHEDULING ORDER

THIS CAUSE comes before the Court *sua sponte*. On June 16, 2021, in compliance with the Court's Order Setting Initial Status Conference [ECF No. 8], the parties filed a Joint Proposed Agenda [ECF No. 24-1]. In that June 16th filing, the parties jointly proposed deadlines, following the Court's determination of plaintiffs' leadership structure, for the filing of a consolidated complaint and a briefing schedule for anticipated motion(s) to dismiss. *See* [ECF No. 24-1]. Having appointed Plaintiffs' leadership structure [ECF No. 43], considered the parties' Joint Proposed Agenda, and being fully advised, the Court hereby directs the parties to adhere to the following schedule:

<u>August 5, 2021</u>. Plaintiffs' deadline to file a single consolidated complaint.

<u>August 26, 2021</u>. The parties shall submit a joint proposed agenda listing items for discussion at the September status conference.

<u>September 2, 2021</u>. The parties shall attend a status conference. The conference will be held via video conference, with instructions to follow.

<u>September 20, 2021</u>. Defendants' deadline to submit a single combined motion to dismiss or separate answers. A joint motion to dismiss may not exceed 40 pages.

October 20, 2021. Plaintiffs' deadline to submit a response in opposition to Defendants' joint motion to dismiss. Plaintiffs' response shall not exceed 40 pages.

November 19, 2021. Defendants' deadline to submit a reply in support of their joint motion to dismiss. Defendants' reply shall not exceed 20 pages.
