IT APPEARING TO THE COURT that a convenience to the public would result in the filing of naturalization petitions at the office of the Immigration and Naturalization Service, and that the preparation of naturalization certificates would be enhanced by utilizing the computer facilities located at the Immigration and Naturalization Service,

IT IS ORDERED that the Office of the United States Immigration and Naturalization Service located at 7880 Biscayne Boulevard, Miami, Florida, be designated as an Office of the Clerk of the United States District Court for the Southern District of Florida, for the purposes of receiving and filing petitions for naturalization, receiving and filing declarations of intention, and collecting fees prescribed by the statutes for the aforesaid petitions.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the following named employees of the Immigration and Naturalization Service be designated as special deputy clerks of this Court for the purposes stated above, but only after they have taken the oath of office prescribed for deputy clerks.
