

O R D E R

This matter having come before the Court upon the recommendation of the Administrative Office of the U. S. Courts to the Clerk that unclaimed funds in the registry of \$100.00 or less should be deposited into the U. S. Treasury. It being noted that Section 2042 of Title 28 does not require the Court to wait a full five years before depositing unclaimed funds. It is therefore,

ORDERED that the Clerk regularly review and notify the Court of funds in the registry in the amount of \$100.00 or less, exclusive of accrued interest, which have remained unclaimed for a period of a year or more. Such funds will be deposited with the U. S. Treasury, upon a specific order of Court, without waiting for the funds to remain unclaimed for five years.
