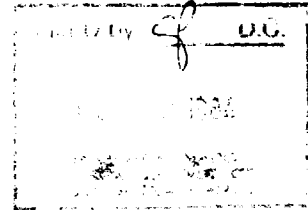

Upon consideration, it is


ORDERED that the collateral forfeiture and mandatory

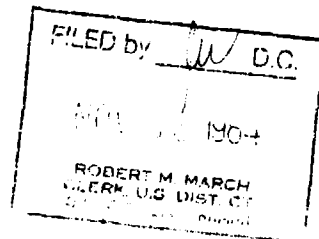


O R D E R
