ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 85-24

IN THE MATTER OF: CONSTITUTING
MASTER AND QUALIFIED JURY WHEELS

ORDER

Pursuant to the provisions of the Jury Selection and Service Act of 1968 (U.S.C. 1861 et seq.), and subject to the provisions of the Local Jury Plan of the Southern District of Florida which authorizes the use of electronic data processing methods, the minimum number of names to be initially selected and recorded for the Master Jury Wheels in each Division as provided under the terms of the Jury Act and Local Plan shall be and is fixed as follows:

Miami Division	250,000
Ft. Lauderdale Division	150,000
West Palm Beach Division	100,000
Ft. Pierce Division	18,000
Key West Division	35,000

IT IS ORDERED that the Clerk shall randomly select and designate, or cause to be randomly selected and designated, the names from the voter registration lists of each county within each Jury division, in accordance with the Plan, it being further


ORDERED that, under direction and control of the Court, the Clerk of Court shall cause such names so designated to be extracted, selected electronically and recorded so as to constitute the Master Jury Wheels for each division. Thereafter, from time to time as required, the names of prospective jurors shall be randomly and electronically selected from the Master wheels for transmittal of juror qualification questionnaires to

establish qualified jury wheels for each division from which there shall be randomly selected electronically the names of persons to be summoned for Grand and Petit Jury service, all in compliance with and subject to the Plan.
