ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 86-2

TEMPORARY ASSIGNMENT OF
RESPONSIBILITY FOR SENIOR
JUDGE EATON'S PENDING CASES

The Honorable Joe Eaton, Senior United States District Judge for the Southern District of Florida, has indicated his intention to take a temporary leave from his regular duties with the court. It is therefore

ORDERED and ADJUDGED that with respect to the attached computer printout list of pending civil and criminal cases presently assigned to the division presided over by Senior Judge Eaton, as follows:

(1) Effective December 31, 1985, newly filed civil and criminal cases will not be assigned to Judge Eaton until further Order of the Chief Judge;

(2) Any emergency motions presented to the Clerk of Court or to Judge Eaton's office shall be referred under the existing procedures for emergency treatment of matters to a district judge in active service;

(3) All other matters, not requiring emergency treatment but nevertheless requiring the attention of an active judge,




shall be referred by the Clerk of Court to any one of the following judges:

Judge James Lawrence King
Judge James W. Kehoe
Judge Lenore C. Nesbitt
Judge Stanley Marcus
Judge Thomas E. Scott

(4) The foregoing procedures for the orderly administration of the attached list of cases shall remain in effect until further Order of the Court.
