ORDER

IN RE: STANDING CONDITIONS OF SUPERVISED RELEASE

Upon consideration, it is


ORDERED and ADJUDGED that, in all criminal cases in which a defendant is placed on supervised release, the following conditions are hereby imposed and shall be observed and conformed to by the supervised releasee unless altered or modified by special order in a particular case. The supervised releasee shall:

- 1) Within 72 hours after discharge from custody, report to the Chief Probation Officer of the District in which he will reside.
- 2) Refrain from violation of any law (federal, state and local). The supervised releasee shall get in touch immediately with his probation officer if arrested or questioned by a law-enforcement officer.
- 3) Associate only with law-abiding persons and maintain reasonable hours.
- 4) Work regularly at a lawful occupation and support legal dependents, if any, to the best of his ability. When out of work, the supervised releasee shall notify his probation officer at once. The supervised releasee shall consult his probation officer prior to job changes.
- 5) Not leave the judicial district without permission of the probation officer.
- 6) Notify his probation officer immediately of any change in his place of residence.
- 7) Follow the probation officer's instructions and advice.

8) Report to his probation officer as directed.

9) Comply with and observe any special conditions of probation which may be imposed in any particular case.
