MAXIMUM TRANSCRIPT RATES AUTHORIZED BY  
THE JUDICIAL CONFERENCE, SEPTEMBER 1986

Effective October 1, 1986, as temporary relief for United States Court Reporters, the following increased maximum allowable transcript rates, subject to the further action of the Judicial Conference thereon following committee reports on said rates. Provided further that said maximum allowable rates will not apply as to any transcripts paid for by the government\* as long as Gramm/Rudman/Hollings\*\* is in effect:

ORDINARY TRANSCRIPT	\$ 3.00	\$ .75	\$ .50

A transcript to be delivered within thirty (30) calendar days after receipt of an order.

EXPEDITED TRANSCRIPT	\$ 4.00	\$ .75	\$ .50

A transcript to be delivered within seven (7) calendar days after receipt of an order.

DAILY TRANSCRIPT	\$ 5.00	\$ 1.00	\$ .75

HOURLY TRANSCRIPT	\$ 6.00	\$ 1.00	\$ .75

\* This exception applies to any transcript ordered by the U. S. Attorney, or under the Criminal Justice Act, or on behalf of a person proceeding in forma pauperis, or in any other circumstance in which the transcript is paid for by funds from the federal treasury.

Transcript produced for the U.S. Attorney or under the Criminal Justice Act, or on behalf of a person proceeding in forma pauperis or paid for by funds from the federal treasury shall be paid for under the rates established February 1, 1984, copy attached.

\*\* Gramm/Rudman/Hollings presently has a five year effective period.
