IN RE: ORDER EXCUSING COLLIER, GLADES & HENDRY RESIDENTS FROM JURY SERVICE IN MIAMI OR WEST PALM BEACH

In accordance with the Eleventh Circuit's approval of the amendments to this District's Jury Plan creating a Naples Jury Division, and it not being logistically nor technically feasible to continue to use Collier, Glades or Hendry County residents as jurors in the Miami or West Palm Beach Jury Division, it is:

ORDERED that beginning April 27, 1987, all Collier, Glades and Hendry residents be excused from fulfilling jury service in this District's Miami or West Palm Beach Jury Divisions.
