ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

In Re: Canceling of  
Duty Magistrate Court Due  
to Visit of President Ronald  
Reagan and Pope John Paul II

On September 10, 1987, the President of the United States and Pope John Paul II will arrive in Miami. For that entire day and the following day, September 11, 1987, all major arteries and roadways in and around Miami will be impassable due to security measures and expected crowds. All law enforcement personnel including the United States Marshal and his deputies and other federal agents will be required for essential security functions.


The United States Magistrates of this Court routinely hold Court at the Courthouse for initial appearances, bond hearings, and the like, on each regular business day. This will be impossible on September 10 and 11, 1987. Possible alternative sites have been considered but are impractical both because access to all reasonable sites will be as impassable as those to the Courthouse and because Marshals will not be available to transport prisoners. Consideration has also been given to the possibility of holding Court on Saturday and Sunday, September 12 and 13, but that is also impractical. Initial appearances and initial bond hearings are not scheduled in advance. Arresting officers place federal prisoners in custody and report to the United States Attorney's Office to draft complaints. Arrests based on out of

town warrants require access to operating Courthouses so that the nature of the charges and essential bond information may be obtained. There is no practicable way to notify the hundreds of local federal agents and other law enforcement officers of a change in the scheduling of Court hearings, and no way to obtain out of town information during a weekend.

Finally, there will, as always, be a duty United States Magistrate available to set temporary bonds based upon all available information by telephone when the Court is not in session. Thereupon, it is

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the regularly scheduled duty Magistrate Court shall not be held on September 10 or 11, 1987, and that regular duty calendars shall resume at 10:00 A.M. Monday, September 14, 1987.
