ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 87-43

In Re: Firearms in Federal
Courtrooms in Southern District

IT APPEARING to the court that for reasons of security and by reason of inability to identify all law enforcement officers who may be in attendance in the court of this district, any previous memoranda or orders issued by this court concerning the carrying or possession of a firearm while attending court are hereby rescinded, and

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that no person may enter any federal courtroom in the Southern District of Florida carrying a firearm, other than a United States Marshal or his deputies.
