2) Applicants seeking admission to practice in this District are required to purchase a copy of the Local Rules Book directly from the Miami Review. The Miami Review will provide the applicant with a proof of purchase receipt, which must be attached to the Petition for Admission.

3) Upon admission to practice a Certificate of Admission will be issued by the Clerk.


Upon consideration, it is

ORDERED that the Courts' directive entered under date of June 1, 1971 as amended October 2, 1973, July 28, 1978, and March 6, April 9, 1981 be and the same is hereby further amended as follows:

Effective from December 30, 1981, in conjunction with new local rules for attorneys' admission to practice, the Clerk shall collect from each attorney seeking admission before this Court a) Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) in accordance with the Judicial Conference Fee Schedule, and b) Twelve Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$12.50) on behalf of the Miami Review for purchase of a Local Rule Book, it being further

ORDERED that filing fees so collected shall be periodically and accordingly disbursed and that each person shall be entitled to receive one copy of the Local Rules for the Southern District of Florida and, upon formal admission to practice, a Certificate of Admission.
